## Arriving by train/bus/metro

Blaubeuren is a railway station on the Ulm-Freiburg line. The hostel is about 700 m from the train station. At the station, cross Bahnhofstraße to Karlstraße and walk down this street for 500 m and then turn right into Ulmer Straße. After about 100 m, turn left into Eduard-von-Lang-Straße. After 100 m, follow the signposted footpath on the right-hand side until you get to the hostel.

- Gerhausen – Hohenstein – Eichhalde – Tugendpfad („virtue path“) – Bleiche (valley walk) (3 hours)
- Gerhausen – Weiler – Tiefental – Sontheimer Höhle (cave) (4 hours)
- Hörnle – (viewpoint, Schiller monument) – Gleißenburg Castle ruins – Höllental – Riedental – Weiler – Blaubeuren (4 hours)
